## GUIDELINES FOR SECTORAL PUBLIC FORUM

1. Electronic copies of each nominee's vision paper and curriculum vitae are downloadable from the UP Diliman Website (<http://upd.edu.ph>).
2. Each nominee shall deliver a 30-minute presentation summarizing his /her vision as to the direction and governance of UPD for the next three years.
3. The incumbent chancellor shall be given a 30 minute to deliver first his end-of-term report and another 30 minute to present his vision paper.
4. The Search Committee had drawn lots to randomly assign the order of presentations of the two remaining nominees on the forum.
5. The search committee will moderate the question and answer portion.
6. The audience will be given time to ask questions after all nominees have presented. Question may be directed to a specific nominee or to all nominees. The question should be concise to allow the nominees to have time to respond to as many as questions as possible. Alternatively, questions may be written down and passed to the Search Committee for sorting. Similar questions will be grouped together to maximize the topics/ issues covered during the forum.
7. Nominees are requested to provide concise answers and deliver each answer within 1 minute.
8. Time marshals will be around to prompt nominees/ participants of the time.
9. Cell phones and similar devices that could interrupt the forum should be placed in silent mode.

## GUIDELINES FOR CONSULTATIVE MEETINGS: UPD CONSTITUENTS AND THE SEARCH COMMITTEE

1. Any member of UP Diliman Community who wish to meet privately with the Search Committee in order to raise a concern/ concerns regarding nominee/ nominees should set an appointment by contacting the Search Committee Secretariat, at: Office of the Dean, Rm. 207 Alonso Hall (College of Home Economics), Telephone Number: 981-8500 local 3401. 2. Consultations may be conducted individually or in groups of up to five (5) persons in a single slot. Each slot is scheduled in 15 minutes segments. UPD constituent(s) is/are requested to select the concerns to be presented to the Committee to give the Committee time to ask questions and finish the consultation within the allotted time.
3. Whenever appropriate, UPD constituent(s) should bring any material/ document that could aid the Committee in understanding the concern/ concerns that had been raised.
4. The Search Committee is also accepting until 5:00 PM of January 10 and 11, 2017 written or emailed statements regarding the qualifications and competence of any of the nominees.
